

AMENDMENT TO BY-LAWS



NOTICE is hereby given of the following action duly taken by the Council of Co-Owners, Jamestown Village, to amend the By-Laws as established by the Master Deed of Turnberry, Inc., said deed made May 22, 1986, of record in the Register's Office for Blount County, Tennessee, in Book of Warranty Deeds 475, page 324, Blount County Courthouse, State of Tennessee.

1. Pursuant to Number 7. of the Master Deed, entitled By-Laws, by a petition signed and completed on May 22, 2002 of at least sixty five percent (65%) of the 50 Co-Owners in Jamestown Village, Exhibit C of the Master Deed, Number 10., entitled, Restrictions on the Use of Units, is amended as follows:

from

"E. No portion of the unit (other than the entire unit) may be rented or leased."

to

"E. No portion of any unit, or the unit itself, may be rented or leased with the following exceptions: The three units presently being rented; specifically, 927 Jamestown Way, 930 Jamestown Way, and 934 Portsmouth Circle may continue to be rented until the present Co-Owner/Co-Owners are deceased or the unit is sold. After either the death of the present Co-Owner/Co-Owners, or sale by same, whichever happens first, the unit cannot be rented or leased under any conditions."

- 2. This amended change replaces Paragraph E. of Number 10., in Exhibit C of the Master Deed. This change is effective upon recordation with the Register of Deeds of Blount County, Tennessee as an amendment to the By-Laws.
- 3. The undersigned acknowledges that the forgoing Amendment to the By-Laws (Exhibit C of Master Deed) and action by the Jamestown Village Board of Directors was legally adopted for and on behalf of the Council of Co-Owners, Jamestown Village.
